



Dear Residents

We are writing to inform you of extended working hours that will take place in the new multi storey car park at Shinfield Studios next week between Monday 23rd and Thursday 26th January. These are not new works, but rather we have lost days due to the extremely cold weather and so these dates simply replace the ones we could not use over the past week. These new dates have been approved by Wokingham Borough Council.

The extended hours are not to lay the concrete itself but the follow-on process that needs to be undertaken prior to it setting.

The contractors will start pouring the concrete at the start of the day due to the large volume of concrete required (100 cubes of concrete per pour), this pouring then continues all day and into the early evening. Once pouring has finished, the power floating process begins.

Power floated concrete is a type of concrete finish achieved by using a machine known as a power float on freshly set concrete. The power float machine is used to smooth, recompact and level the concrete floor once all bleed water has evaporated and uses rotating circular blades to buff the surface, resulting in highly polished concrete flooring. Given the size and nature of the machinery and the multistorey car parks location by the M4, we don't envisage any noise disruption to neighbouring residents.
