Message from Oakbank Headteacher, Steve Jump

I wanted to take the opportunity to introduce myself to the residents of Shinfield Parish. I had the pleasure of joining Oakbank as Headteacher in May 2022 following many years as an Assistant and Deputy Headteacher serving a variety of schools in Hertfordshire.

I am sure many of you have memories of Ryeish Green, the school that formally occupied our school site. The school has been adapted and changed substantially over the years. Most recently we have replaced and upgraded the windows in the old Victorian section of the school. Some of you may have also noticed that we had to remove the bell tower from the school (for safety reasons). Thankfully we were able to salvage the old bell which is now proudly displayed in our

reception area for staff, students, and visitors to see as they enter the school. The site has been replanted over the past four years with support from the Woodland Trust as well as our lovely neighbours Laurels Garden Centre and is flourishing. Walking past the school, you may have noticed the addition of two flagpoles at the front of our reception building; one to display the winning house for the week and one to show our support of national and international events that the school is celebrating. Recently we displayed the Black History Month flag as well as one for Remembrance Day.

In the classroom, our staff are passionate about their subjects, and we work together as a community to ensure high quality learning and teaching is taking place; as well as offering our students opportunities to participate in extra-curricular activities from sporting competitions to science and strategy clubs. Our refreshed library is creating quite a buzz in school with a wide range of brand-new books along with several new seating areas. We are also fortunate to be supported by a strong PTA who organise bake sales and discos for our students; as well as providing the ice creams on Sports Day which we held on the large field behind the school in the Summer term!

We are keen to open our doors to the local community and are passionate about improving outcomes for all our students. If you feel you can offer us any support in terms of careers provision, religious and spiritual guidance (we are fortunate already to be supported regularly by Shinfield Community Church as well as Bright Hope Church and the Loddon Benefice), or just want to come and have a look around the school, please do get in touch.

We have a community event taking place in on the 7th December when we hold our annual Christmas Market. There will also be a Christmas Showcase taking place with performances in music and drama from our young people which you are more than welcome to come along to!

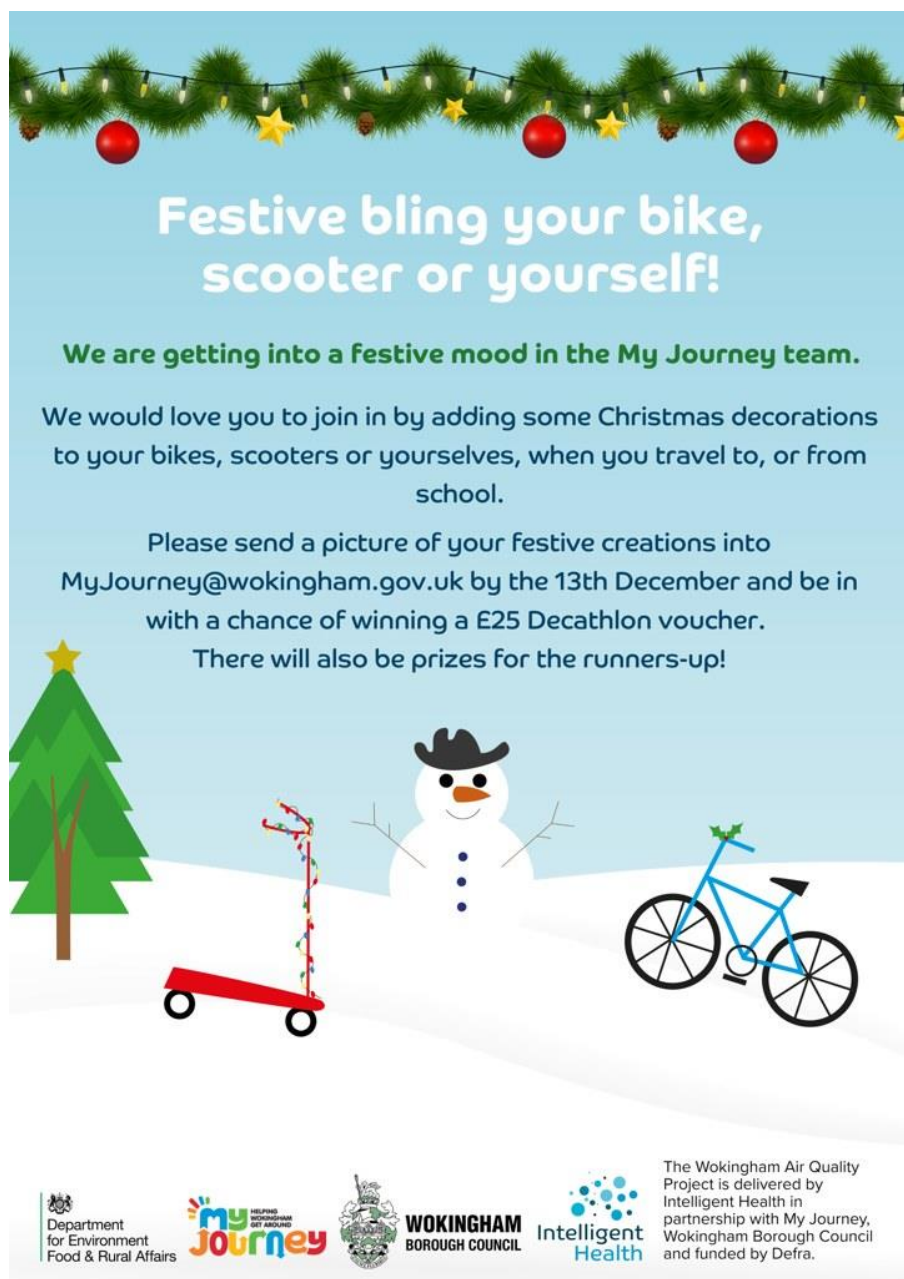
