

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

(GRAZELEY ROAD, THREE MILE CROSS)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that Wokingham Borough Council as Traffic Authority proposes to make an Order under Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along:

1. Grazeley Road, Three Mile Cross at its junctions with Basingstoke Road.

Works requiring this restriction are expected to take place between 30th January and 1st February 2024.

The reason for these prohibitions is to allow TWU contractors to undertake relay of service in the road in safety.

Access for residents and businesses within the boundaries of these restrictions will be maintained at all times.

The restriction imposed by the Order shall only apply during those periods when traffic signs complying with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are lawfully displayed.

The restrictions contained in the Order shall come into operation on the 30th January 2024 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
