

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

(HARTLEY COURT ROAD, THREE MILE CROSS)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that Wokingham Borough Council as Traffic Authority proposes to make an Order under Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along:

Hartley Court Road, Three Mile Cross between its junctions with Hartley Close and Great Lea.

The alternative route for all vehicles affected by this restriction shall be via Hartley Court Road, Kybes Lane, Pingewood Road South, Amners Farm Road, Burghfield Road, Hermits Hill, Reading Road, Burghfield Road, Victoria Road, The Street, Bloomfield Hatch Lane , MereOak Lane and Great Lea or by this route in reverse.

Works requiring this restriction are expected to take place on 22nd August 2024 between 9.30 and 15:30.

The reason for these prohibitions is to allow BT contractors to carry out a pole replacement in safety.

Access for residents and businesses within the boundaries of these restrictions will be maintained at all times.

The restriction imposed by the Order shall only apply during those periods when traffic signs complying with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are lawfully displayed.

The restrictions contained in the Order shall come into operation on the 22nd August 2024 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
