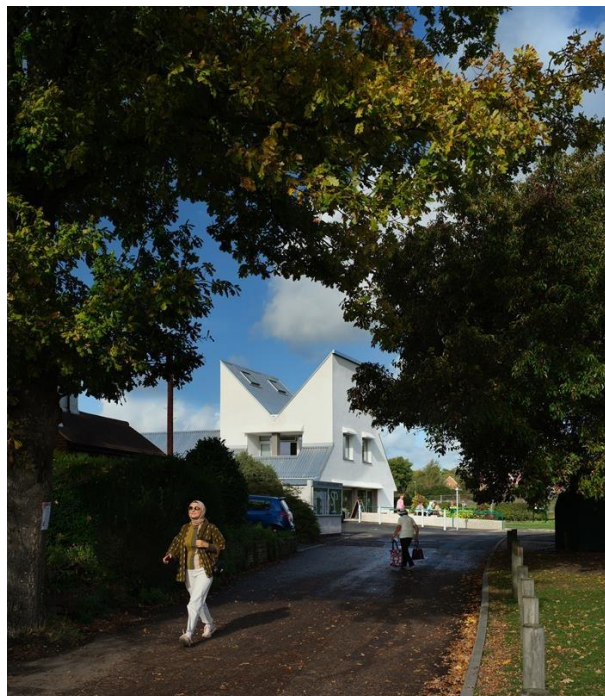

COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION

Dear Neighbours,

We wanted to update you with the latest news from Shinfield Studios. We are very pleased to tell you that heavy construction on the main site is complete.

This means that the vast majority of construction traffic has ended. However, you might notice that we are still extremely busy with landscaping -we are planting 700 trees and a further 10,000 native shrubs and bushes, some industrial machinery is required to plant and care for them until they have established.

The result of all of this activity is a world-leading film and TV studio in the heart of Shinfield. The site includes 18 sound stages and many supporting facilities, all now in operation and providing a production home for some of the most famous film and television series.

MAKING LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS

Alongside the construction of Shinfield Studios, we have worked to provide or fund some improvements to local infrastructure, for the benefit of everyone. This has included:

- Lighting the Cutbush Lane pedestrian bridge, over the M4 (completion July)
- Upgrade of local footpath no.3 (Map for reference <https://shinfieldparish.gov.uk/wp-content/uploads/2022/03/Shinfield-Footpath-Map-2022-2.pdf>)
- The completion of a new 800m permissive path and cycle way. This runs parallel to the existing FP4
- Two new kissing gates have been given to the local Loddon Valley Ramblers group
- We are rewilding several areas of farm track to bring them back to natural habitat, this includes St John's Copse. Hedgerow is also being reinstated in this area, amongst others.
- Extensive flood prevention measures have also been implemented

SHINFIELD CINEMA/SCREENING FACILITY



School Green Centre, Shinfield

Together with Shinfield Parish Council, we have agreed a plan to provide a flexible screening facility for the local community at the School Green Centre in the heart of Shinfield. We have funded retractable tiered seating, state of the art sound and projection equipment with a screen to give the community an 80 seat capacity cinema. We are delighted to have the Parish Council manage this facility and they are planning a range of uses including after-school matinees, Friday Film Nights and half-term film seasons (starting with a "Sing Along Cinema" in October). REQUESTS FOR COMMUNITY TOURS

We have received many requests for tours. As we are a working studio, we must honour the confidentiality needs of the films being made here so, are sadly unable to facilitate routine public tours. We do not have any permanent film sets to see or opportunities to view filming taking place. The only public insight into the making of films in the UK is the excellent Warner Bros Studio Tour in Hertfordshire. And we thoroughly recommend that for a really great overview of the whole production process. It is Harry Potter orientated, but you don't have to be a HP fan to enjoy the insight into how productions are made.

However, we have been thinking of ways that we can show you, the local residents some of the studio site and enable you to gain an understanding of how the studios are operated. Therefore, we are discussing with the Shinfield Cinema at School Green Centre ways of holding competitions to win mini tours. We are also supporting some local events and charities where opportunities to also win mini tours will be possible. CREATION OF SCREEN BERKSHIRE

Shinfield Studios is a founding member of Screen Berkshire. This cluster is made up of some amazing companies and has been established to help provide pathways for people into jobs and training in TV & Film production. This could be anyone, from new starters to people upskilling or returning to work. It's funded by the British Film Institute (BFI), with National Lottery money.

Screen Berkshire has already hosted multiple workshops, training schemes and networking opportunities. We recently welcomed the Minister for Employment, Jo Churchill to Shinfield Studios to watch a short film being created by University of Reading students & participants of a Sector-based Work Academy Programme (SWAP). This particular initiative is run with the Berkshire Job Centre and was designed to equip participants with the knowledge, skills, and contacts to access work in film and the wider creative industries.

Information from University of Reading

"In collaboration with St. Mary's C of E Primary School, the University is facilitating the provision of an outdoor, meadow classroom. During consultation with the school, the one wish that was voiced by the children was to have a wildlife pond. Work has been in progress for a few months, erecting fences, forming a teaching circle of benches, installing bird boxes, hedgehog homes and a bug hotel. Trees have been planted and currently the wildlife pond is under construction. The pond will be accessible to the public and the space is due to be opened on National Meadows Day, Saturday 6th July."

WHAT IS PLANNED?

The key elements of the proposals are as follows:

- A range and mix of housing (up to 450 homes) including affordable homes to meet local needs;
- Small business units to provide local employment opportunities;
- Local shops and services within a local centre, including potential doctors surgery;
- Country Park;
- 3G football pitch and changing facilities;
- Primary school;
- Playing fields and play areas;
- Community pavilion;
- Pedestrian and cycle routes connecting to existing areas;
- Community orchard; and
- Areas for wildlife and flood storage.

Our landscape-led proposals will be designed sensitively to fit in with the character of the Area to provide a mix of uses that enhance the community. Development will also contribute to improvements to the local road network and routes for walking and cycling. The proposals have been informed by assessments and surveys of the land and local area.

Shinfield Volunteer Group Footpath Report - June 2024





Welcome to our June footpath report. There was very little activity but here are a few snippets for you.

We received a report about the foliage almost blocking footpath 6 where it passes what was once the Magpie and Parrot. We were quickly able to clear this and the following week one of my ramblers colleagues joined me and we levelled a hump that was sloping towards the ditch. This revealed some old chain link fence which we cut out and disposed of.

We don't have an update on the report we submitted to WBC about some rotten planks on the footbridge along footpath 18 up near the motorway.

We don't have an update on the report that Loddon Valley Ramblers submitted to WBC regarding the condition of Byway 25 (Woodcock Lane).

Footpath 7 is now open from Oatlands Road through into the new housing estate although it was still to have its top dressing of Tarmac.

There were several reports submitted to WBC about the foliage at the end of footpath 13 leading onto Hyde End Lane. We are pleased to thank the Countryside Rangers for quickly dealing with this.

Finally, I led a team from Loddon Valley Ramblers and we replaced the rotten way mark post and finger signs at the junction of footpath 31A and 32A in the field beyond Grazeley Village Hall. I have included before and after photos for your interest.

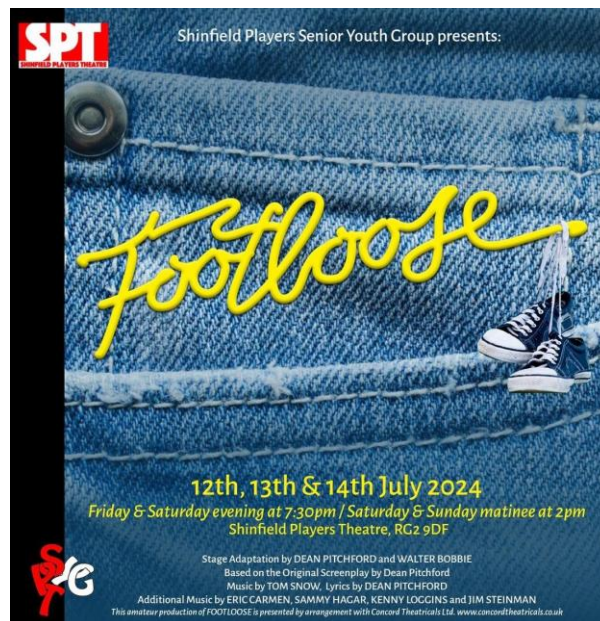
