

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

(GRAZELEY ROAD, THREE MILE CROSS)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that Wokingham Borough Council as Traffic Authority proposes to make an Order under Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along:

Grazeley Road, Three Mile Cross between its junctions with Wallace Grove and Basingstoke Road.

The alternative route for all vehicles affected by this restriction shall be via Tabby Drive and Basingstoke Road or by this route in reverse.

Works requiring this restriction are expected take place between 1st December and 3rd December 2025 between 08.00am and 18.00

The reason for these prohibitions is to allow BT contractors to carry out Telecoms excavations to lay duct and build joint boxes and clear potential blockages in safety

Access for residents and businesses within the boundaries of these restrictions will be maintained at all times.

The restriction imposed by the Order shall only apply during those periods when traffic signs complying with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are lawfully displayed.

The restrictions contained in the Order shall come into operation on the 1st December 2025 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
