

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

(HARTLEY COURT ROAD, THREE MILE CROSS)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that Wokingham Borough Council as Traffic Authority proposes to make an Order under Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along:

Hartley Court Road, Three Mile Cross between its junctions with Great Lea and Access Road from Kybes Lane to Kirtons Farm Road.

The alternative route for all vehicles affected by this restriction shall be via Access Road from Kybes Lane to Kirtons Farm Road, Kirtons Farm Road, Berrys Lane, Burghfield Road, Reading Road, Burghfield Road, Victoria Road, The Street, Bloomfield Hatch Lane, Lambwood Hill, Mortimer Road, Mere oak Lane and Great Lea or by this route in reverse.

Works requiring this restriction are expected take place between 2nd December and 3rd December 2025 between 09.30 and 15.30

The reason for these prohibitions is to allow BT contractors to carry out telecoms cabling and associated works in safety.

Access for residents and businesses within the boundaries of these restrictions will be maintained at all times.

The restriction imposed by the Order shall only apply during those periods when traffic signs complying with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are lawfully displayed.

The restrictions contained in the Order shall come into operation on the 2nd December 2025 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
