

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

WOKINGHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

(WHITE HOUSE LANE, SPENCERS WOOD)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that Wokingham Borough Council as Traffic Authority proposes to make an Order under Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along:

White House Lane, Spencers Wood between its junctions with Yew Tree Lane and Beech Hill Road

The alternative route for all vehicles affected by this restriction shall be via Yew Tree Lane and Beech Hill Road or by this route in reverse.

Works requiring this restriction are expected take place between 16th February and 18th February 2026

The reason for these prohibitions is to allow BT contractors to renew, replace, raise and lower Frame and Cover in safety

Access for residents and businesses within the boundaries of these restrictions will be maintained at all times.

The restriction imposed by the Order shall only apply during those periods when traffic signs complying with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are lawfully displayed.

The restrictions contained in the Order shall come into operation on the 16th February 2026 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
